### Competition Guidelines

- Participants will be provided a A4 printed picture by MOF for Colouring.
- Students may use any type of Colouring materials such as crayons, Colour pencils, sketch pens or water Colours.
- The competition aims to encourage Creativity, Colour sense and Artistic expression among young learners.





## DRAWING ART OLYMPIAD (DAO)

DAO is a Poster Making Competition organized for students of Grade 3rd to 12th.

### Competition Guidelines

- Participants will be provided a drawing sheet by MOF.
- Participants may use any Colouring medium of their choice.
- Participants must prepare a poster on any one of the given topics.

#### Grade 6 to 8

- Future Earth

#### Grade 9 to 12

## INDIAN ART OLYMPIAD (IAO)

*Promoting India's Rich Artistic Heritage Among Students*

**IAO is a Free Hand Drawing Competition organized for students of Grade 6th to 12th.**

The Indian Art Olympiad (IAO) is organized to encourage students to explore traditional Indian folk art.

This edition of the IAO focuses on the beautiful and vibrant **Madhubani Art**, known for its intricate patterns, cultural symbols and colourful designs.

### Competition Guidelines

- Participants will be required to create an artwork in the Madhubani Art style.
- A4 Drawing sheet will be provided by MOF to all participants.
- Students may use any Colouring medium such as Crayons, Pencils, Sketch Pens, Poster Colours, Water Colours, Etc.
- Participants are encouraged to include traditional Madhubani motifs, such as Nature, Animals, Birds, Cultural Symbols or Decorative Patterns.

**Group 1:** Standard 6th to 8th **Group 2:** Standard 9th to 12th



## WRITING ART OLYMPIAD (WAO)

**WAO is an Article/Essay Writing Competition organized for students of Grade 3rd to 12th.**

### **Competition Guidelines**

- Group-wise Article/Essay topics will be provided to the participants.
- Article/Essay may be written in English, Hindi or Gujarati.
- Participants must write an Article/Essay on any one of the given topics.

### **Article/Essay Writing Topics**

**Grade 3 to 5** (Approx. 200 words)

- My Dream For India
- If I Were A Superhero

**Grade 6 to 8** (Approx. 300 words)

- Technology : Friend or Enemy
- My Role In Making The World Better

**Grade 9 to 12** (Approx. 350 words)

- Importance of Technology In Education
- Youth Power : Shaping Tomorrow





## SCHOOL LEVEL AWARDS & PRIZES

### **Participation Certificate**

All participants at the School Level will receive a Participation Certificate.

### **Honourable Certificates**

Special Honourable Mention Certificates will be awarded to recognize outstanding performance.

### **Merit Certificates**

Special Merit Certificates will be awarded to participants for commendable efforts.

### **Teacher Appreciation Award**

A Class Teacher will receive a Special Gift for 30 or more entries from his/her respective class in the Olympiad.

### **Special Recognition for Schools**

Schools sending more than 300 entries will have their Principal and one Co-ordinator honoured with a Special Gift.

### **Appreciation Certificate for School Principals & Coordinators**

All School Principals & Coordinators associated with the Olympiad will be awarded an Appreciation Certificate in recognition of their valuable support and coordination in successfully organizing the competition at the school level.

### **Awards – CAO (Colouring Art Olympiad)**

In CAO, Class-wise 1st, 2nd and 3rd position holders will be awarded:

- Gold Medal – 1st Position
- Silver Medal – 2nd Position
- Bronze Medal – 3rd Position

### **Awards – DAO, IAO & WAO**

In DAO, IAO and WAO, Group-wise 1st, 2nd, and 3rd position holders will be awarded:

- Gold Medal – 1st Position
- Silver Medal – 2nd Position
- Bronze Medal – 3rd Position



## STATE LEVEL AWARDS & PRIZES

### Group-wise Competition

All Olympiads at the State Level will be conducted group-wise.

- Group-1 : Pre-School
- Group-2 : Grade 1st & 2nd
- Group-3 : Grade 3rd To 5th
- Group-4 : Grade 6th To 8th
- Group-5 : Grade 9th To 12th

### Eligibility for State Level

The 1st Prize winner from each school in each Olympiad will qualify to participate in the State Level Competition.

### Appreciation Certificate

All participants at the State Level Competition will receive an Appreciation Certificate.

### Consolation Prize (Top 10 Winners):

After 1st, 2nd & 3rd Rank, the Top 10 students in each category and each group will be awarded a Consolation Prize of **Rs.1100 Cash + Shield**.

## State Level Prizes

### 1st Prize

- Shield
- Certificate
- Cash Prize of **Rs.11,000/-**

### 2nd Prize

- Shield
- Certificate
- Cash Prize of **Rs.7,500/-**

### 3rd Prize

- Shield

## RULES & REGULATIONS

### Participation Fee

The participation fee for each competition is Rs.120 per entry.

### School Administrative Charges

Schools may retain Rs.20 per entry as administrative charges.

### Multiple Participation

Students may participate in more than one Olympiad.

### Collection of Materials & Fees

The MAO Representative will collect all competition materials and participation fees from the school.

### Minimum Participation Requirement

A minimum of 50 students per school must be enrolled for the application to be accepted.

There is no limit on the maximum number of students who may participate.

### Awards – CAO (Colouring Art Olympiad)

In CAO, Gold, Silver, and Bronze Medals will be awarded to the Top Three performers in each class.

### Awards – DAO, IAO & WAO

In DAO (Drawing Art Olympiad), (IAO) Indian Art Olympiad and WAO (Writing Art Olympiad), medals will be awarded group-wise.

### Minimum Entries for Medal Eligibility

- For below 5 entries – No medal will be awarded.
- For 5 entries – Only Gold Medal will be awarded.
- For 6 to 9 entries – Gold and Silver Medals will be awarded.
- For 10 or more entries – Gold, Silver, and Bronze Medals will be awarded.

### Judging Criteria

Winners will be selected strictly on the basis of performance, creativity, and overall presentation, as evaluated by the panel of judges.

### Submission of Student List

The list of participating students must be submitted in the prescribed format provided by the organizers.



## RULES & REGULATIONS

### **Format of Student List**

The student list must be submitted in English only and written in CAPITAL LETTERS.

### **Participation in Multiple Competitions**

Students may participate in all competitions and may submit multiple entries such as essays, posters, or colouring sheets, where applicable.

### **School-Based Participation**

Individual participation is not permitted. Applications must be submitted only through schools.

### **Details on Each Entry**

Each entry must clearly mention the following details on the back side of the sheet:

- Student's Name
- Class & Section
- School Name

### **Payment of Participation Fee**

The school is required to pay the participation fees at the time of registration through online payment or cash, as instructed by the organizers.

### **Dispatch of Competition Materials**

After the completion of the competition, all entry materials must be properly packed in the courier bags provided by the organizers and dispatched to the MOF Cluster Office.

### **No Re-Competition or Fee Refund**

Once the courier has been dispatched, re-competition will not be permitted and participation fees will not be refunded for absentee students.

### **Best School Award**


The Best School Award will be decided based on both quality and quantity of participation.
